

Greater Jacksonville Association, Inc.
General Meeting Minutes
Tuesday, May 21, 2019

GJA met on the above date at Fairview United Methodist Church. President David Perrott called the meeting to order at 7:45 pm. In attendance were approximately 20 people. Mr. Perrott introduced the GJA officers and board members present.

The minutes of the March 19 meeting were approved as submitted. In Mr. Peters' absence, Mr. Perrott presented the Treasurer's Report. At the end of April 2019, the account balance was \$16,019.49.

The announced speaker, County Planner Kaylee Justice, proved to be unavailable and will be asked to speak at a future meeting.

Mr. Perrott reviewed information posted about solar farms in Baltimore County. A meeting will be held in July on the Green Road site. Mr. Jack Armstrong made a motion for GJA to write to the County Council and County Executive expressing GJA's concern about solar farms on prime farmland and advising caution in moving forward too quickly in approving these sites. The motion carried.

Ms. Lehmann reported that the recommended amendments to GJA Bylaws were posted on the website for review and comment. Members were asked to review the proposed changes, email with any comments or concerns, and to vote on the changes at this May 21 meeting. Mr. David Palmer made a motion to approve the amendments to the GJA bylaws. The motion was seconded and carried.

There is no new information about on the "log cabin" area/the Goldberg property. There was consensus that the site was in poor repair and that GJA should contact county code enforcement citing it as an attractive nuisance. The liquor store in the Manor Center is scheduled to open under new management in June. The Citgo station has reopened as a Sunoco station under new management.

The Warren Road reservoir bridge has been closed for emergency repairs and will not reopen until September. It is scheduled to be replaced in approximately three years.

Future GJA membership meetings for 2019 will be held on the following dates: September 17 and November 19.

Since there was no other new business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:30 pm.
