General Membership Meeting
September 19, 2023

The GJA membership meeting was held on the above date at Fairview United Methodist Church. The meeting was called to order by President David Palmer at 7:00 pm. There were approximately 35 people in attendance.

The minutes of the May meeting were accepted as presented.

Treasurer Marc Peters reported that the GJA account balance at the end of August 2023 was \$10,344.64.

Guest speaker State Senator Chris West provided a legislative update.

After the guest's presentation, Mr. Palmer reviewed the status of several issues of interest to the community. He reported that Baltimore County has asked for the 2000 Jacksonville Community Plan to be updated as much of the information and issues are no longer relevant and demographics have changed. He asked for help with this initiative. He introduced Abigail Rogers, the county planner for our area.

Under new business, Mr. Palmer reported that GJA plans to work with the Optimists and the Carroll Manor Rec Council to revive the Fourth of July fireworks. Volunteers are also needed for this initiative.

There is no update on the McDonalds/Dunkin site's progress. Permits are still needed.

As there was no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:30 pm.
